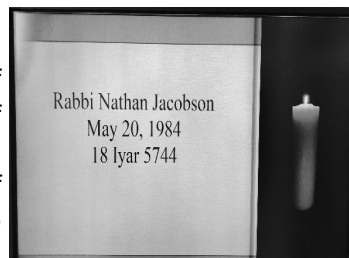

Remembering Your Loved Ones

The Electronic Yahrzeit Memorial Board, which is located inside and to the left of the Main Entrance of the Jewish Community Center of Canton, replaced the Bronze Wall Boards that were in the lobby of Shaaray Torah Synagogue. The Board is shared by Shaaray Torah and Temple Israel, and alphabetically displays the names of all individuals for whom a spot or plaque was purchased.



The Electronic Yahrzeit Memorial Board uses a modern technologically advanced software program, which will automatically display the name and date-of-death of the deceased on the large monitor at the appropriate yahrzeit date. It will display the Yahrzeit for two weeks: 1 week before the yahrzeit to 1 week after. The board also has an available search function, by which individuals are able to search for friends' and relatives' yahrzeit dates using the interactive touch screen.

The board contains the information for Shaaray Torah members and relatives, who had a plaque on the old wall boards prior to 2010. Deaths and subsequent yahrzeit dates of individuals, which occurred after 2010, are not automatically displayed on the electronic memorial board unless a space has been purchased. For anyone who reserved a plaque or space, their name will automatically be added at the time of their death.

The cost to add your loved one's name to the Yahrzeit Board is \$300. Spaces may be pre-purchased, or purchased at the time of death. If you have additional questions, call (330-492-0310), or email Patti in the Shaaray Torah office shaaraytorahcanton@gmail.com.

By purchasing a space on the Electronic Yahrzeit Memorial Board, you are ensuring that your loved one's name will be displayed and read perpetually at Services on the annual Yahrzeit anniversary date.

My summer weekend will be July 20/21. On Shabbat, we will introduce our new Shabbat & Festival Siddur, Lev Shalem, and companion Prayer book to our recently purchased Machzor for the High Holidays. This prayer book will greatly enhance our Shabbat services and I will devote my Friday evening and Saturday morning Divrei Torah to various aspects of the new Siddur. On Saturday evening, we will observe Tisha B'av as we commemorate the destruction of the First and Second Temples and various other calamities that our people have suffered throughout the ages. Hazzan Braun will chant the book of Lamentations, which describes the destruction of the First Temple in 587 BCE and its aftermath. I look forward to seeing you at services, at Friday night Shabbat dinner and at Shabbat morning Kiddush luncheon as well as Saturday evening.
